The Important Events/discussions/decisions pertaining to Coir Board for the month of December 2014 are furnished below.

Shri. Kalraj Mishra, Union Minister for MSME visited coir industry units in Kerala during 20-21, December 2014.

Shri. Adoor Prakash, Minister for Revenue and Coir, Govt. of Kerala, Shri.P.H.Kurian, Principal Secretary (IT), Shri. Sathyajith Rajan, Principal Secretary (Industries) and Smt. Rani George, Secretary, Culture and Coir Department were also present during the discussions.

The issues relating to the MSME Sector of Kerala was discussed at length and it was decided to have a more closer coordination with the Central Govt. organizations and the State Govt. departments.

Further discussions were also held in detail about the MSE-CDP cluster proposals submitted to the Ministry and other issues related to KVIC, NSIC and MSME DI.

Besides, the following important events also took place at the meeting:

- 1) Formal launching of the modified central scheme (REMOT) implemented through Coir Board.
- 2) Releasing of C.Ds on e-learning programmes of Coir Board.
- 3) Releasing a film on "Coir Darshan" in Hindi.

The inaugural session was followed by Seminars, on various topics on MSME funding and Coir, for the whole day.

The meeting was also attended by the Grama Panchayath President and other officials of the Coir development department of Govt. of Kerala

Thereafter on the way to Kalavoor, the venue of the public function, visits were made to household units functioning in and around Alleppey. The following units which were provided assistance under various Schemes of the Govt. of India were visited.

- 1. Maji Coir Works (Shri. N.M. Joseph), Nadeeparambu, Thumbolly P.O., Alleppey (4 handlooms for Mats weaving. Assisted under REMOT Scheme of Coir Board.
- 2. Shri.Thomas Pooney, Venice Coir Consortium, Kalavoor P.O., Alleppey.

In both the units, production activities were being carried out.

The need for adaptation of modern techniques of processing, quality improvement and competitiveness was brought to their notice and Coir Board officials for progressing further in the matter of more operational efficiency.

The present definition and categorization of MSMEs may be revised by suitably enhancing the limits.

- 1. Imposing a ban on the import of rebounded foam.
- 2. A National Coir Policy to be formulated and announced.

Concluding the meeting, the need for emphasizing on quality improvement, competitiveness, enhanced raw-material utilization were appraised in general. The above suggestions and other issues came up in the meeting will be examined in greater detail and decision taken. It was clarified that the Central Government is very keen in developing industries like coir which provides employment to lakhs of rural artisans and bringing in valuable foreign exchange.

A meeting with the entire staff of Coir Board at the Coir Board Headquarters was held. The employees were given opportunities to express their opinion and grievances if any. The representatives of the staff of the Board who spoke on the occasion said that they implementing the directives of the Union Govt. under the Swatch Bharath Abhyan and implementation of e-office in the Coir Board is under progress. The following were the major aspects brought to the notice by the employees' representatives:

- 1) Expeditious rectification of anomalies in the Recruitment Rules.
- 2) Filling up of vacant posts under the Coir Board.
- 3) Enhancement of non-plan allocations or granting permission to meet a portion of salary component from the plan allocations, to meet the committed expenditure towards salary and pension.

Responding to this, the employees were informed that the issues relating to staff problems will be considered on merit and appropriate action taken at the Board's / Government level wherever required. The employees were told that their performance will have to be rated with reference to the positive responses they are able to create within the stakeholders of coir industry and the public in general. All the employees should come forward and put in their best efforts for the speedier and efficient delivery of their services to the beneficiaries and Coir Board.

## I. S&T ACTIVITIES

During the visit of Shri.Kalraj Mishra, Hon'ble Minister MSME at CCRI on 21.12.14, the following activities have been done:-

- Coir Geo Bag for erosion control has been released
- Coir Polyester Composting Moulding has been launched
- 6 spindle "Naveena" spindle machine launched
- Inaugurated Poly Coir Farm for growing vegetables and medicinal plants
- Transfer of technologies developed by the Coir Board to 15 entrepreneurs from the States of Kerala, Tamil Nadu and Karnataka.

 Distribution of certificates to 20 Nos. of women master trainers passed out of the National Coir Training and Design Centre of Coir Board.

### II. TRAINING

A total number of 1992 women workers were trained in spinning of coir yarn and manufacture of value added products. Besides, 8 Nos. of Entrepreneurship Development Programme, 4 Nos. of Quality Improvement Programmes, 9 Nos. of Awareness Programmes and 6 Nos. of Workshops were also organized in the major coir production centers.
