As desired, the important events/discussions/decisions pertaining to Coir Board for the month of **October 2012** are furnished below.

I. S&T ACTIVITIES

- In order to popularize the MFEM, field demonstrations have been conducted using the mobile advertisement van for towing the MFEM for the extraction of coir fiber from coconut husk. The demonstrations were conducted at 3 places in the Alappuzha district.
- CCRI participated in one day workshop on coir industry at N.
 Paravoor, Gothuruthy, Kadalvathuruthu and Municipal auditorium,
 Attingal organized by Regional Office, Thiruvananthapuram and
 Kerala Institute of Local Administration(KILA) Thrissur and taken
 classes on the new R&D technologies developed the institute viz.
 application of Coirret for quality improvement of green husk fibre,

composting of coir pith using Pithplus, treatment of coconut husk retting effluent, Cocolawn etc.

II. REJUVENATION, MODERNIZATION AND TECHNOLOGY UPGRADATION SCHEME (REMOT)

a. <u>REMOT Scheme</u>

The 4th High Level Apex Committee of the REMOT Scheme held on 20.10.2011 decided that Board has to follow the extant provision of the Operational Guidelines of the REMOT Scheme and a separate empanelment of machinery manufacturers has to be made for supply of machinery to the beneficiaries of the REMOT Scheme. Accordingly, Board invited bids through paper notification for empanelment of coir machinery manufacturers under REMOT Scheme. After verifying the infrastructure facilities of the technically qualified bidders, the 12th Evaluation and Steering Committee of REMOT Scheme held on 09.08.2012 empanelled 39 coir machinery manufacturers for the supply of machinery under REMOT Scheme.

b. Coir Board Coir Workers' Group Personal Accident Insurance Scheme

During the month of October 2012, four insurance claims were settled by M/s. United India Insurance Co. Ltd., Ernakulam under the Coir Board Coir Workers Personal Accident Insurance Scheme. A sum of Rs.1,70,000/- was paid as compensation to the claimants.

c. Meeting of NGOs at Trivandrum

Chairman Coir Board hold a meeting of the Non-Government Organizations and SHGs registered in Trivandrum, Kollam, Pattanamthitta districts of Kerala on 25.10.2012 at Municipal Library Auditorium, Attingal to disseminate the Schemes and Services of the Board and to request them to take lead in the implementation of the projects. The Chairman said that the Board is in the process of training 20,000

coir artisans this year and implementing various projects like REMOT, DPI etc and exhorted the participants to spin hands with the Coir Board in implementing the projects.

III. EXPORT MARKETING.

Participation in the Mega Show Part I, Hong Kong

Coir Board facilitated participation of Indian Coir sector in the **Mega Show Part I** held at Hong Kong during 20th –23rd October 2012. Five Entrepreneurs / Exporters participated in the Fair in separate booths.

The response was very encouraging and the Entrepreneurs / Exporters received genuine trade leads from the exhibition.

Participation in Catalogue Show:

Coir Board made arrangements for display of catalogues, brochures and promotional literatures in the Catalogue Show at Buraidha, Saudi Arabia held during October 2012 organized by Chamber of Commerce and Industries, Riyadh, Saudi Arabia.

Exporters Meeting

Chairman held a meeting on 08.10.2012 with the Presidents and Vice Presidents of all Exporters Associations and their Federation of the Coir Sector in order to discuss the present status of export of coir products from India and to strategies the action plan for boosting up the export of Indian Coir Products. The meeting resolved to work for better products innovation, customization of products on the basis of market requirements etc. The Association representatives have appealed to Coir Board to amend the EMDA Scheme to increase the level of assistance and number of times of assistance available in a year. Chairman assured to take up the matters with the Govt.
