SIGNIFICANT ACHIEVEMENTS/EVENTS DURING JANUARY 2020 (from 25th Dec 2019 to 24th Jan 2020.

I. Science & Technology

• Visit of Public Accounts Committee at CCRI, Coir Board Complex, Kalavoor on 08/01/2020

The Lok sabha public Accounts committee visited at CCRI, Coir Board Complex, Kalavoor on 08/01/2020 and the official meeting was conducted at Alappuzha, Kerala.

• Symposium on Research and Development Needs of Coir Industries at Alappuzha on 13.01.2020

A Symposium on Research and Development Needs of Coir Industries has been organised jointly by the Regional Office, Alappuzha and the Central Coir Research Institute, Kalavoor at Alappuzha on 13.01.2020. At the symposium technical experts, Scientists and exporters made presentations on the requirement of the industry, particularly in the field of Research & Development. The Symposium was also attended by the Director, NCRMI and the representatives of Kerala State owned public sector undertakings. In the symposium a consensus was arrived at that there should not be any duplication of research activities by CCRI and NCRMI. A brain storming was also conducted to elicit new R & D project ideas to be taken up in future.



• Development of flame retardant rubberized coir for cushioning purpose in railways

Studies were carried out to improve the flame retardancy characteristics of the rubberised coir by different treatments and tested at CIPET, Hyderabad (the RDSO recognized laboratory). As the result of the studies conducted, the above properties could be improved to a greater extent compared to the untreated one. For the parameter resistance to spread of flame modified sample have improved and passed from Class C to Class A. The final stage of the research in order to reach LOI value 35 and to achieve the Toxicity Index, laborotary studies are conducted in CCRI.

IV. EXPORT MARKET PROMOTION

Promotion of exports of coir and coir products and carrying on propaganda and publicity for that purpose is an important function assigned to the Coir Board. The Export Market Promotion Programmes implemented by Coir Board is to promote the export of coir products to markets abroad which are borne under the ongoing scheme Coir Vikas Yojana. Coir Industry is an export oriented industry and export helps the industry to adjust the imbalance between the production and demand in the domestic market. Exports help to attain sustainable development with a healthy growth rate.

Special/significant achievements, if any: Nil

* Only 8 exhibitions have been approved by the Ministry for participation during 2019-20 under the I.C Scheme and the first event was on October 2019.

V. (A) COIR UDYAMI YOJANA (CUY)

Coir Udyami Yojana is a credit linked subsidy Scheme. The Scheme provides for financial assistance to the tune of 40% of the investment in Building and Plant & Machinery for setting up of coir production units. The remaining amount towards investment is funded through term loan (55%) from Banks and 5% through beneficiary contribution. Assistance under the Scheme is made available to individuals, Companies, Self Help Groups, Non Governmental Organizations, Institutions registered under Societies Registration Act 1860, Production Cooperative Societies, Joint Liability Groups and Charitable Trust. The maximum admissible cost under the Scheme is Rs.10 lakhs plus working capital, which shall not exceed 25% of the project cost.

(B) PRIME MINISTER'S EMPLOYMENT GENERATION PROGRAMME (PMEGP)

Prime Minister's Employment Generation Programme is a credit linked subsidy scheme for setting up of new micro enterprises. The Scheme provides subsidy at the rate of 25% of the project cost in rural areas and 15% in urban areas to the General Categories and 35% in rural areas and 25% in urban areas to the Special Categories, which includes SC/ST/OBC/Minorities/Women/Physically Handicapped/Ex-servicemen, NER, Hill and Border areas. Coir projects with maximum cost up to Rs.25.00 lakhs in Manufacturing Sector and Rs.10.00 lakhs in Business/Service Sector are eligible for assistance under the Scheme. The Scheme is opened to individuals, Self Help Groups, Institutions registered under Societies Registration Act 1860, Production Co-operative Societies and Charitable Trust.
